

## Frank Rausche Presented the G. Brooks Earnest Award

Frank Rausche, Ph.D., P.E., has been awarded the 2009 G. Brooks Earnest Technical Lecture Award by the Cleveland Section of ASCE. Dr. Rausche is president of GRL Engineers, a partner in Pile Dy-



namics, and a founder of both companies, both ADSC member firms. He is a prominent researcher and one of the early pioneers of the field of Dynamic Testing of Deep Foundation and Wave Equation Analysis of Pile Driving. He will deliver the Technical Lecture in Cleveland this fall.

This prestigious award was established by the Cleveland Section in honor of G. Brooks Earnest, who was its president in 1943, National President of ASCE in 1962, and President of Fenn College from 1952 until the formation of Cleveland State University in 1964. The award is presented yearly to an outstanding individual of prominence in the field of Civil Engineering. Previous recipients include Ralph

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Peck, Elio D'Appolonia, James Mitchell, and many other distinguished engineers.

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
